The LAFO has become one of the most recognizable flute choirs in the Los Angeles area, performing at venues ranging from the Dorothy Chandler Pavilion and the Disney Hall - Redcat Theater, to the Palos Verdes South Coast Botanical Gardens and the City of Baldwin Hills Summer Park Concerts. The group recently performed a recital at the 2010 National Flute Association's Convention in Anaheim CA, which was received with great praise.
