#### **“THE CALIFORNIAN FOOTSTEPS BY NEVIN WONG”**

An opening reception for “The Californian Footsteps by Nevin Wong” will be held on **Sunday, January 29 at 1 p.m.** Mr. Wong will be speaking about his photography and there will be an opportunity to discuss the works with him. Admission to this event and the exhibition is free of charge.

This event is part of the *Gateway Photography Initiative*, a special program for artists to forge collaborative works. This season we combine the concept of an art exhibition with an education program to inspire young artists to create new photographic works.

Originally from Hong Kong, Nevin Wong moved to Los Angeles in 2004 to complete his education. The wondrous landscapes in the U.S. captivated him, and this was his motivation to start visiting National parks and capturing the diverse scenery of the country. He is presenting a collection from his travels through California and its neighboring states. Twenty-four works will be on display beginning January 22 at the Gateway Gallery.

A second part of the program is an educational component, in which members of the youth of the Gateway Christian Church will be welcomed as Associate Artists. Nevin will go into the field with them and guide them in creative photography. Their works will be showcased during a group show starting on April 22.
