Gateway Performance Series (GPS) opens its 2019 Season by presenting a concert titled “Maiden Voyage: The Journey to Jazz,” featuring Nashville-based flutist Michael Morton and his quartet, on **Saturday, April 27 at 7:30 p.m.**

A night of jazz standards and stories, Michael Morton will be accompanied by pianist Alan Chan, bassist Ken Wild and drummer Jamey Tate. Program features music from the American Songbook including tunes composed by Chick Corea, J.J. Johnson, Oliver Nelson, and many others.

GPS’s 2019 Season presents three concerts that cover dynamic musical landscapes, encompassing genres such as Classical, Jazz and beyond. Upcoming concerts include Rachel Mellis on 6/1. Taiwanese bel canto soprano Lin-lin Chang will travel to Los Angeles to collaborate with The Alan Chan Jazz Orchestra for a concert titled “The Trans-Pacific Songbook,” during her American tour, on September 1.

Now celebrating its tenth season, GPS has welcomed over a hundred accomplished artists from around the country and abroad, encompassing a variety of artistic disciplines including music, visual arts and poetry, to forging collaborations since 2009.
